Wednesday, Oct. 1—*Baltimore Mandolin Quartet*—The Quartet was founded in 1999 by members of the Baltimore Mandolin Orchestra in order to explore this little-known repertoire. In addition to bringing the works of past masters of the mandolin to modern audiences, their concerts feature new arrangements and original compositions by mandolinist Jonathan Jenson.

Wednesday, Oct. 8—*Kathie Trahan*—Kathie Trahan is the principal flutist with the Annapolis Chorale, Columbia Pro-Cantare and Prince Georges Philharmonic Orchestras.
