Wednesday, Nov. 5—*Tim Roberts*—Native Texan Timothy Roberts is the principal saxophonist and national tour soloist with the U.S. Navy Band. He has performed in Canada, Europe, and Russia, as well as in the U.S. He won the National Symphony's Concerto Competition. The Washington Post has described his performances as "simply stunning."

Wednesday, Nov. 12—*Rosanne Conway and Miriam Avalos*—Pianists Rosanne Conway and Miriam Avalos bring decades of musical experience to the Village Center for this one-of-a-kind performance. Ms. Conway started her performing career at the age of 16, with the Seattle Symphony. She studied in both Washington and Colorado, then in Europe where she won awards for study in Germany and Austria. Ms. Avalos gave her first public performance at age 3, which led to admittance to the National Conservatory of Music in her native Peru. At 12, she was performing with the National Symphony of Peru. She won full scholarships to the Eastman School and Peabody Conservatory. She has performed at the Phillips Collection, Dumbarton Concert Series, Royal Academy in Stockholm, Purcell Room in London and State Department tours of China and Brazil.

Wednesday, Nov. 19—*Project Natale*—Lou and Joe Natale deliver a smooth style of music, successfully blending sounds derived from the deep moody tones of Joe's upright bass and the bright toe-tapping sounds of Lou's drumming.

Wednesday, Nov. 26—*Barrie Goodman*—Jazz instrumentalist Barrie Goodman teams with cabaret singer and actress Patsy Grady Abrams for a night of nostalgic music ranging from the '20s to the '50s.
