Wednesday, Aug. 1 — Tim Roberts Saxophone Band — Native Texan Tim Roberts is the principal saxophonist for the U.S. Navy Band. He has toured throughout Canada, Europe and the United States.

Wednesday, Aug. 8 — Machaya Klezmer— This high-energy, nationally recognized klezmer band returns to Friendship Heights in August. Formed in 1988, the band has mastered the feeling and dynamism of authentic klezmer music and has duplicated the marvelous and lively sound of the famous klezmer bands of the 1930s. Wednesday, Aug. 15 — Project Natale— Lou and Joe Natale have been performing traditional jazz with Project Natale since 1990. She has appeared at the Spoleto Festival in Melbourne, Australia, and has sung major roles in the Washington Savoyards and Washington Opera.
