Wednesday, March 5 — *The Culkin School of Irish Dance* — Featuring traditional Irish dance, this school has performed at numerous famous venues in the Washington/ Baltimore area and with many internationally renowned Irish musicians, including the Chieftains, Cherish the ladies, Eileen Ivers, Lunasa and Natalie MacMaster. The dancers have also participated at many local festivals, including the Potomac Celtic Festival, the Maryland Renaissance Festival and the Washington Irish Festival.

Wednesday, March 12 — *Jack Stanton*—An evening of high-energy performance, Jack Stanton returns for a special St. Patrick's Day concert featuring the guitar, banjo and vocals.

Wednesday, March 19 — *Richard Miller*— Brazilian born Miller's repertoire ranges from classical guitar works to the Brazilian equivalent of American ragtime. He has toured South and Central America as well as the U.S. in both classical recitals and with Latin jazz bands.
