**Wednesday, Nov. 6—*Roseanne Conway and Barbara Cackler***—Hailed by critics for her “musical elegance and brilliant technique,” pianist **Rosanne Conway** is a native of Seattle, where she performed with the Seattle Symphony at age 16. She holds degrees from the University of Washington and the University of Colorado. She has performed at the American Liszt Society Festival at the Kennedy Center and has appeared in many local and regional concert series as recitalist, chamber music player and accompanist. Currently on the faculty of the National Cathedral School, Ms. Conway also maintains a private studio. **Barbara Peterson Cackler** was raised in Kansas, where she began studying the piano at the age of four. She received her Bachelor of Music degree from Oberlin Conservatory of Music and her Master of Music degree from Yale School of Music. Ms. Cackler maintains a private teaching studio and is a member of the American Guild of Organists, the Friday Morning Club and the MTNA.

**Wednesday, Nov. 13—*Susan Jones and String of Pearls***—Violinist Susan Jones is a familiar favorite of Friendship Heights audiences. Known for her exceptional talent in groups ranging from Machaya Klezmer to Mariachis de Los Compadres, this time Ms. Jones brings her trio to the Village Center for an evening of classical music.
