




WEDNESDAY EVENING CONCERTS

Wednesday, Oct. 7—Herb Smith—Saxophonist Herb Smith pays tribute to alto sax jazz legend Charlie Parker whose innovations in jazz improvisation influenced every serious jazz player who followed. The performance features a mix of Parker's compositions and standards from the Great American Songbook.
