Wednesday, Oct. 3 — It Takes Two — This piano duo features Roseanne Conway and George Peachey. Mr. Peachey has performed in concert at the Kennedy Center, the Corcoran Gallery, and various embassies.

Wednesday, Oct. 10 — Dixie Power Trio—Hailing from Fredericksburg, Va., this four-man “trio” delivers an exciting combination of New Orleans jazz, Dixieland and zydeco. Led by Zack Smith, the band also features Andy Kochenour, Wayne Wilkinson, and Byron McWilliams.
