
Site Concept

DESCRIPTION

The Purple Beech Tree will be the central feature of the park. There are three areas A is for children age 2-5. Area B is a sitting area that contains bench, and trash receptacle, Area C is for the 5-12 age group. The park is ADA accessible, the access to the park will be colored concrete and brick walks in a running brick pattern will be used to access the areas. A fence will surround the two play areas and the tree. Benches are provided at several locations. The poured in place surface is green, there are several beige circles within this surface. Equipment is beige, green, and light brown.

The back of the playground is open to save the beech tree. The gazebo and playground are fenced by a black 4' high fence. The beech tree is also fenced in by a 4' high black fence, and does not connect to the playground. There is no retaining wall in front, but there will be retaining walls in the rear. The tire swing and barbecue pits will be removed prior to construction, and picnic tables relocated.






