Celebrate Verdi with the glorious *Il Corsaro*

The Washington Concert Opera will present Giuseppe Verdi's *Il Corsaro*, performed by acclaimed tenor Michael Fabiano who has performed in major houses around the world: the Met, the San Francisco Opera, and, Milan's La Scala. We will leave the Village Center at 5 p.m. and return before 10 p.m. The cost of the trip, which includes a seat in Center Terrace (at a 20% discount), transportation to Lisner Auditorium, and driver gratuity, is \$110.
