Discover the brilliance of internationally known glass artist Dale Chihuly when we travel to Richmond, Va. We should return to the Village Center by 7 p.m. The cost of the trip, which includes round-trip transportation, lunch, admission to the Virginia Museum of Fine Arts and the Chihuly exhibit, and the audio guide, is \$109.
